Water Main Replacement Overview

The City of Phoenix is replacing aging underground infrastructure with new water mains and service connections in the area shown on the map. Work will start July 9, 2018 and last until approximately May 2019. This infrastructure upgrade will be performed by the City's contractor, Redpoint Contracting.

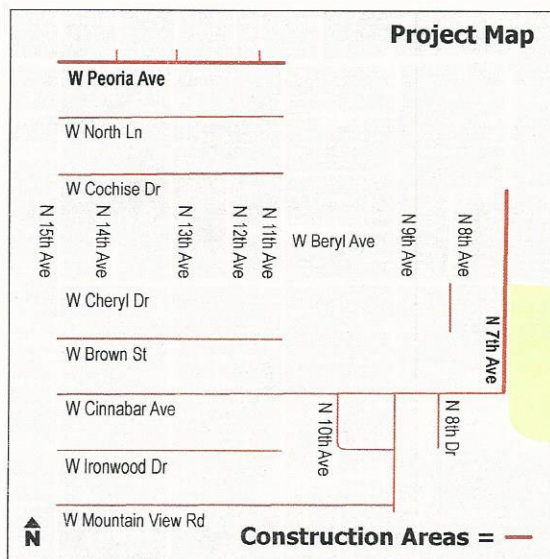
These sections of pipe need to be replaced immediately to ensure sufficient water delivery is maintained. Repairs are anticipated to take approximately 10 months.

Water Service is not anticipated to be disrupted. However, residents and businesses will be notified if any water service interruptions occur.

Traffic Restrictions in Your Area

Due to the nature of this work, drivers will experience traffic restrictions within the construction work zone, but significant effort will be made to keep as many lanes open as practical to allow the work to be completed on or ahead of schedule.

- Work hours are 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, although some night and/or weekend work may be necessary.
- On-street parking may be restricted as necessary to complete the work. The contractor will notify people in advance of any such restrictions.
- Short periods of water service interruption may be necessary to tie in the new services. You will be notified at least 48 hours in advance of any service interruptions.
- Crews will not work the entire area at once; however the entire area will be considered a construction zone, so your patience and attention to safety are appreciated!
- Access to residences will be maintained.
